Nuclear Activities (Prohibitions) Repeal Bill 2023

A Bill for an Act to repeal the Nuclear Activities (Prohibitions)
Act 1983, to consequentially amend the Electricity Industry
(Residual Provisions) Act 1993, the Mineral Resources
(Sustainable Development) Act 1990 and the State Electricity
Commission Act 1958 and for other purposes.

The Parliament of Victoria enacts:

1 Purposes

The main purposes of this Act are—

- (a) to repeal the Nuclear Activities (Prohibitions) Act 1983; and
- (b) to consequentially amend the Electricity Industry (Residual Provisions) Act 1993, the Mineral Resources (Sustainable Development) Act 1990 and the State Electricity Commission Act 1958.

This Act comes into operation on the day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3 Repeal of the Nuclear Activities (Prohibitions) Act 1983

The Nuclear Activities (Prohibitions) Act 1983 is repealed.

4 Consequential amendment of the Electricity Industry (Residual Provisions) Act 1993

In section 3(1) of the Electricity Industry (Residual Provisions) Act 1993, in the definition of *undertaking*, omit ", but not by the use of a nuclear power reactor".

5 Consequential amendment of the Mineral Resources (Sustainable Development) Act 1990

Section 113(4) and (5) of the **Mineral Resources** (Sustainable Development) Act 1990 is repealed.

6 Consequential amendment of the State Electricity Commission Act 1958

In section 3(1) of the **State Electricity Commission Act 1958**, in the definition of *undertaking*, **omit** ", but not by the use of a nuclear power reactor".

7 Repeal of this Act

This Act is repealed on the first anniversary of the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Note

The repeal of this Act does not affect the continuing operation of the amendments made by it (see section 15(1) of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**).
